HELP US PROTECT YOUR RIGHTS A CITIZEN LED (NO LAWYERS) INITIATIVE



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We, Neil McDougall and Karen Churchill, are pressing ahead with a unique Judicial Review (JR) against the government to safeguard our rights to public health protection afforded by a three year period set in the 2018 EU Exit agreement.

The government deny responsibility, and we are holding them to account.

We have worked voluntarily for four years to build up the evidence which proves that the government have neglected their public health responsibilities and that they have failed to clarify the local authorities legal obligations to risk assess the impacts of 5G.

Currently local planning authorities are not always checking to see whether there are residents within unsafe radiation zones, as defined by the government own exposure guidelines.

When you object to planning applications on health grounds, you have a right that your objection is fully taken into account, especially when you provide the peer reviewed scientific evidence of increased risks within 500m, risks to the vulnerable including children, the elderly and evidence of the impact to those with Electrohypersensitivity (EHS) symptoms and metal implants. Likewise when science is presented about the adverse effects to plants and animals. Peer reviewed science is available on rfinfo.co.uk, qr code below). There is a procedural standard in the European Electronics Communication Code (EECC) but when the government implemented the EECC in December 2020 they did not empower the local authorities to enact the required risk reconciliation. Many masts are refused on visual amenity grounds, so do object whilst this legal case proceeds.

Thousands are left susceptible to short-term symptoms such as headaches, nausea, tinnitus, dizziness, sleep disturbances and concentration issues, as well as an increased risk of long-term effects including possibly cancer.

EHS was recognised as a disability by the Upper Tribunal (High Court equivalent, so precedent setting) in June 2022 when an education health care plan was awarded to a UK child. EHS has also been recognised as a condition warranting early ill health retirement. <u>Link</u>. Despite these awards, the government is slow to recognise the condition; they mainly infer the symptoms are psychosomatic, and deem mitigation of exposure unnecessary.

We seek justice and protection for all citizens, especially those suffering from Electrohypersensitivity (EHS), a condition not fully recognised by the UK government as they deem mitigation of exposure to wireless radiation unnecessary. We now need cover our costs to continue with this vital challenge. We very much appreciate your support. THANK YOU.
